A professional regional theater based in Greensboro, NC, Triad Stage celebrates diverse voices, perspectives, and lived experiences through the arts. We have recently redefined and restructured our organization and programming with a renewed purpose and commitment to anti-racism and to community standards that shape our work. We celebrate new work, amplify community voices, and share the stories of our changing region. We value our partnerships with arts organizations, university partners, and local businesses. For 20 years, Triad Stage has been known for groundbreaking productions in our downtown facility that includes a 299-seat thrust and an 80-seat flexible cabaret space.

JOB DESCRIPTION

Bartenders will be responsible for welcoming customers, planning drink menus and informing customers of specialty cocktails along with other bar offerings. ServSafe Alcohol Training will be provided to ensure safe & legal alcohol service. Taking inventory, adhering to all food safety and quality regulations, handling cash, credit, and debit card transactions, maintaining a clean work area by removing trash, cleaning the bar and behind the bar, and developing new cocktail recipes are all responsibilities of a Bartender. Bartenders have the ability to converse about Triad Stage MainStage productions, events, and initiatives to enhance sales and community relations. This position requires the individual to be at least 21 years of age and to work in a fast-paced sales environment standing for extended periods.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The responsibilities of this position include, but are not limited to:

- Provides an excellent patron experience at all performances
- Safely serve beer, wine, spiritous cocktails, and other concessions during the preshow hour, at intermission and other intervals as called for by the production needs
- Serve as bartender for special events and rentals as needed
- Use provided cleaning supplies to sanitize bar area before and after shift
- Remove trash at the end of shift
- Record bar inventory as assigned
- Assists in maintaining the appearance of the lobby and all public areas; communicates with House Manager and Box Office Manager as necessary to ensure a clean and safe environment
- Assists in enforcement of audience-side COVID-19 protections
- Assists House Manager in emergency situations, including fire alarm and inclement weather warnings
- Other bar/concessions-related duties as assigned

EXPERIENCE AND QUALIFICATIONS

Successful candidates will be organized, friendly, and able to engage with guests to enhance their experience. Must be able to stand and lift 30 lbs. Candidates must be at least 21 years of age. Candidates must participate in ServSafe Alcohol Training. Bartending experience preferred, experience in food service and/or event concessions are a plus. Must have knowledge of and commitment to the [workforce DEIA experience](#) and adhere to our Anti-Racism and Community Standards. Must attend company training sessions as needed. Must participate in the company's COVID-19 protocols.

PT, \$10/hour + tips when appropriate, \$15/hour for nontipped events (4-hour minimum pay per shift)
