



the basics

- Camps are taught by professional teaching artists, and class sizes are capped at 16 students to provide each student with individualized training and support.
- Tuition for week-long camp sessions is \$250. Tuition for the two-week Scriptworks camp is \$500. Some scholarship assistance is available through a formal application process.
- All camps run from 9:00am-4:00pm at Triad Stage (232 S. Elm Street) in Greensboro. Morning and afternoon extended care options are available for an additional fee.
- All students have the option to bring a lunch from home or receive lunch free of cost from Guilford County Schools' Summer Food Program. We recommend also bringing a refillable water bottle.
- All camps will conclude with an informal sharing of students' work on the final day of camp.

RISING 4TH-6TH GRADERS

Playmaking: Twisted Fairytales // June 17th-21st

Interested in improv? Want to explore exciting stories and create your own? RISING 7TH-9TH GRADERS

Performance Essentials // June 17th-21st

Have you ever wanted to know the tools of acting? Learn how actors use their bodies, voices and imagination to become different characters on stage. This camp will give students an opportunity to learn, practice and refine their acting skills. No previous acting experience necessary.

Puppetry & Mask-Making // June 24th-28th

Learn how to sculpt found objects into character masks and puppets for performance! Work with cardboard, tape, glue, paper mache, paint, and other recycled materials to create masks and puppets, and learn a variety of performance techniques to bring these creations to life.

Tell Your Story: Playwriting // July 8th-12th

Always wanted to tell YOUR story the way YOU want to tell it? This camp offers students the opportunity to create their own characters, worlds, and stories through writing their own monologues, scenes, and short scripts. The camp will consist of both written and active performance activities, and is an ideal choice for students who are excited about independent as well as collaborative work.

Scriptworks (TWO WEEK CAMP) //

July 8th-12th AND July 15th-19th

Want to develop your acting skills AND get to tell your own story? This camp is perfect for you! Students in this two-week experience will work together with their lead teaching artist to imagine, draft, rehearse, and perform their own short performance. Ideal for students with any level of prior experience, this camp offers a chance to develop performance, collaborative, and imaginative skills across all areas of theatre.

Scenes & Monologues for Actors // July 15th-19th

Ready to take your acting to the next level? This camp is for you! Students will explore acting through performing various individual monologues and scenes, as well as learn a host of tips and tricks for making their acting the most compelling it can be. This camp is a great opportunity to work on acting skills such as identifying and playing objectives, activating subtext, and working with given circumstances. Ideal for students who have some prior experience with theatre.

RISING 10TH-12TH GRADERS & 2019 GRADUATES

Scene Study for Actors // June 17th-21st

Deepen your performance skills in this intensive exploration of scenework. This camp is ideal for students who are excited to make their performances more connected and compelling. Appropriate for all prior experience levels. Students will be provided with scenes when they arrive at the camp and do not need to bring additional material with them.

Monologues & Audition Techniques // June 24th-28th

Designed for busy high school students, this session offers a deep dive into how to prepare monologues for stellar auditions and compelling onstage performances. Students will receive individualized instruction from the lead teaching artist and will also work collaboratively with other camp participants. Students may bring monologues they are already working on for upcoming auditions, and will also work with some new material. Ideal for students who have some previous acting background and training. If you're interested in pursuing a career in acting, this is the camp for you.
